

- 1998 Planning
- 1999 Training
- 2000 BD and Neonatal Population Registires initiated
- 2002 Volyn+Rivne > *NTD* ~ *20 per 10000 livebirths* (*Yuskiv et al. 2004*)
- 2003 3rd set of conjoined twins solely in the Rivne region
- 2006 Higher NTD rates in Rivne-Polissia
 - 6th set of Conjoined twins noted in Rivne
- 2007 Focus on NTD Twins Omphalocele Body Stalk ... Blastophies Complex



OMNI-Net is VIRTUAL and REAL

- > Medical professionals are employed by major regional medical centers.
- > Resource Centers are an integral part of regional medical centers (caviat; dedicated to BD care-prevention)
- > Programs are only undertaken by agreement with local health authorities
- > Registered as a not-for profit Ukrainian International organization.
- > Recipient of grants and donations
- > Deploys resources as shared property
- > Provides a basis for collaborative agreements linking multiple oblasts
- > Provides a basis for multi-oblasts links with national/international partners.
- > Welcomes parental support organizations
- > Welcomes individuals as partners



Flow of National - International Initiatives

Usual "centralized" flow

Central Authorities > Select Oblasts > Oblast Selects Partners

Alternative "decentralized" flow

OMNI-Net > OMNI-Net partners > Oblast Authorities > **Central Authorities**



STRATEGIES

- Network OMNI Resource Centers (Resource Sharing)
- Local Authorities (Health and ...) Partners
- Web (computer and information-electronic resources) (IBIS ...)
- Telemedicine (national and international)
- Prevention Provider-Parents-Consumer links

TACTICS



- Start in regions (oblasts)
- Locate OMNI-Centers in key (interested) medical centers
- Train local professionals (neonatologists, medical geneticists ...)
- Stress web and English competent staff
- Sustain transparency of activities and data



Current Status

- Ombudsman Facilitation Logistical support (English competent staff, Internet) for national-international initiatives)
- Experience: implementation of initiatives funded per World Bank, USAID, Swiss, Sweden, ... NIH, CDC, ...
- Welcomes pilot trials of potential research partnernships
- co-sponsor of courses, training and workshops
- programs aimed at orphanage reforms
- parental support groups
- Seeks to materialize a "Polissia" Initiative –
- International data review/analysis panel



Conclusions

 Based on these preliminary results, measurement of the frontal area of the brain on prenatal ultrasound may be an early indication of risky alcohol exposure during pregnancy

- A source of serious iatrogenic developmental disorders







